

Rainy Days Quilt

Finished quilt top size: **Small: 4 x 5 blocks - 38" x 47.5" without added borders**

Large: 5 x 6 blocks – 47.5" x 57" without added borders

Materials:

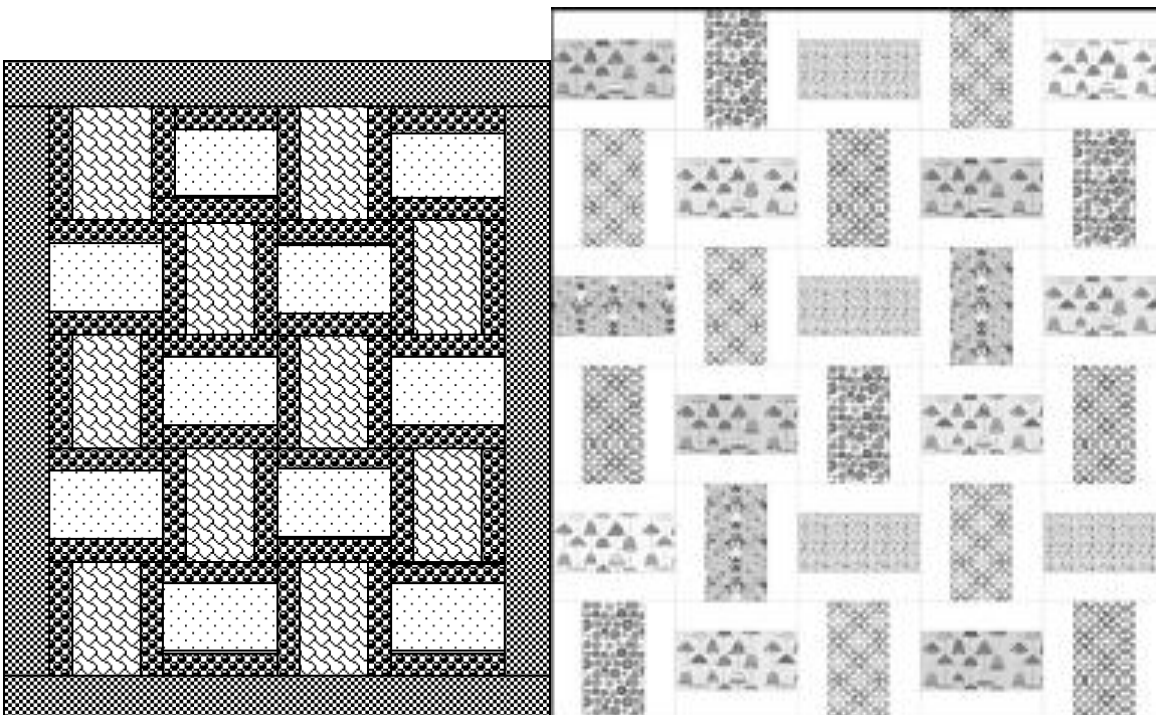
- **Eight 1/4-yard cuts of varying prints or all the same print 1 1/2 yard at 42 inches wide**
- **1 1/2 yards solid or other coordinating print fabric for sashing at 42 inches wide**

Step 1– From the novelty fabric cut: (20) 6" x 10" rectangles for small quilt, or (30) 6" x 10" rectangles for large quilt.

Step 2- From the coordinating fabric cut: (40) 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles for small quilt, or (60) 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles for large quilt.

Step 3- Sew 2 1/2" rectangles to opposite sides of novelty fabric blocks. Blocks should now measure 9.5" square.

Step 4 – Sew blocks as shown in examples below. The small quilt will be 4 blocks across by 5 blocks long. The large quilt will be 5 blocks across by 6 blocks long.



Step 5- Add borders as desired.

Notes:

Quilt tops can be made using varying prints. Not all the focus fabrics need to match.

Different sized blocks may be made using this overall pattern as long as the block size is consistent within each quilt.

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
